ORDER

**Sub: Unlock - 3 Implementation Orders for the
period August 1st to August 31st, 2020.**

Vide Order No.40-3/2020-DM-I(A) dated July 29th, 2020, Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA), Government of India has issued new guidelines for Unlock-3.


Accordingly, the following Implementation Guidelines are hereby issued in the State of Rajasthan for the period August 1st to August 31st, 2020.

A. CONTAINMENT ZONES/CURFEW AREAS:

These are areas where there is substantive outbreak of COVID-19 positive cases and there is a need to contain the spread of the virus. Such area will be suitably earmarked and notified by the District Collector concerned. Strict protocol will be observed in the Containment Zones as per the MHA/Ministry of Health & Family Welfare (MoHFW) guidelines and only essential activities shall be allowed. There shall be strict perimeter control except for medical emergencies and for maintaining the supply of essential goods and services. Prohibitory orders under Section 144 Cr.P.C will be issued by the concerned district authority.

No relaxations of any kind shall be permitted in the Containment Zones.

The District Authorities will also identify **Buffer Zones** outside the respective Containment Zones and will determine the restrictions of required, on such activities for such areas as are deemed necessary.



B. NEGATIVE LIST/PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES:

The following activities will continue to remain prohibited across the State till further orders:


1. Activities prohibited during Unlock 3 period outside the Containment Zones:
 - (i) Schools, colleges, educational and coaching institutions will remain closed till 31st August, 2020. Online/distance learning shall continue to be permitted and shall be encouraged.
 - (ii) Cinema halls, swimming pools, entertainment parks, theatres, bars, auditoriums, assembly halls and similar places shall remain closed.
 - (iii) International air travel of passengers shall only be, as permitted by MHA.
 - (iv) Metro Rail services shall remain closed.
 - (v) Social/political/sports/entertainment/academic/cultural/ religious functions and other large congregations shall NOT be permitted.

C. PERMITTED ACTIVITIES (CONDITIONAL):

All activities permitted vide Order of even number dated May 31st, 2020 and Addendum dated June 6th, 2020 & 30th June, 2020, i.e. not in the negative list/prohibited activities category, shall continue to remain permitted with the restrictions/precautions specified in those orders.

In addition, the following activities will be permitted; subject to conditions mentioned against them:

1. **Small places of worship** (temple, masjid, gurudwara etc.) **in rural areas**, which used to have an average daily visit of up to 50 persons per day, prior to the Lockdown, may continue to be opened subject to the following conditions:




- (1) Entry of persons be staggered in such manner that the number of persons inside the place of worship at one point of time are limited to the extent that social distancing of at least 6 feet is ensured between each such person.
- (2) All persons inside such place shall necessarily wear a mask.
- (3) The SOP dated June 4, 2020 for religious places/ places of worship issued by Ministry of Health & Family Welfare (MoHFW), Government of India shall be followed to the extent it is practical for these small places of worship.
- (4) Any other specific directions issued by the Collector & District Magistrate, based on the recommendation of the District Level Committee on religious places in regard to the do's and don'ts to be observed within each kind of place of worship.

All other places of religious worship viz. temples, mosques, churches, gurudwaras etc. shall be permitted to open from September 01st, 2020 with certain conditions/protocol. Separate guidelines will be issued for that, subsequently.

- 2. Shops** must **NOT** have more than 2 (small shops) or 5 (larger shops), customers at a time, depending upon space available, on the condition that adequate physical distance shall be maintained between customers.

3. Independence day functions

Independence day functions at District, Sub-Division, Municipal and Panchayat levels, will be allowed **ONLY** by following health protocols e.g. sanitization of the public space



to be used for the function, ensuring social distancing and wearing of masks.

4. Yoga institutes and gymnasiums **will be allowed to function** from 5th August, 2020 for which, Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) will be issued by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare (MoHFW), Government of India.
5. **Marriage related gathering** may be held with following conditions. The organizer shall:
 - (1) give prior information to SDM
 - (2) ensure social distancing during the function
 - (3) ensure that the maximum number of guests allowed shall not be more than 50.

Violation of any of the above conditions is an offence and punishable with heavy fine.

6. **Funerals/last rites** related gatherings - Social distancing shall be ensured and the maximum number of persons allowed shall not be more than Twenty (20).


D. COMMON SAFETY PRESCRIPTIONS

The following **standard SAFETY precautions and restrictions** shall remain **applicable** for all areas and all districts:

1. IN PUBLIC SPACES:

The following precautions, **being essential for public safety**, are mandatory and **violation** of the same shall be **punishable with fine**.

- (1) **Face Covering:** Wearing of face cover is compulsory in all public and work places and during public transport.



- (2) **Social distancing:** Each person shall maintain a distance of 6 feet) in public places.
- (3) **Spitting in public & work places is prohibited** and punishable with fine.
- (4) **Consumption of liquor, paan, gutka, tobacco etc. in public place is prohibited** and punishable with fine.
- (5) All persons are advised to wash hands with soap & water or use sanitizer if soap and water are not readily available; after touching any surface that is prove to public contact.

2. AT WORK PLACES:

In addition to 1 above, the following additional safety precautions are prescribed **for WORK PLACES** (Offices, Establishments, Factories, Shops etc.):

- (1) **Work from home:** As far as possible, the practice of work from home should be followed.
- (2) **Staggering of work/business hours** will be followed in offices, work places, shops, markets and industrial and commercial establishments.
- (3) **Screening & Hygiene:** Provision for thermal scanning, hand wash and sanitizer will be made at all entry and exit points and common areas.
- (4) **Frequent sanitization** of entire workplace, common facilities and all points which come into human contact et. door handles etc. shall be ensured, including between shifts.
- (5) **Social Distancing:** All persons in charge of work places shall ensure social distancing between workers, through adequate distance between workers, adequate gaps between shifts, staggering the lunch breaks of staff etc.
- (6) All employers shall encourage and motivate their employees to install, and use, on their mobile phones, *Arogya Setu* for common and personal safety.
- (7) Intensive communication and training on good hygiene practices shall be taken up.

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The District Magistrate and other authorized officers **shall enforce Common Safety Prescriptions**, as stated above, **through fines and penal action** as prescribed in the **Disaster Management Act, 2005/The Rajasthan Epidemic Diseases Ordinance, 2020**.

3. SAFETY ADVISORY FOR VULNERABLE PERSONS:

Vulnerable People viz. Persons aged 65 and above, Persons suffering from Chronic diseases/co-morbid conditions, Pregnant women and Children below 10 years are strongly advised to **stay at home** and move out only for essential and health purposes. If unavoidable circumstances require them to be out of home, they shall exercise utmost safety precautions as specified from time to time.

E. MOVEMENT OF PEOPLE/TRANSPORT/PASSES:

- (i) There shall be **no restriction on inter-State and within State movement of persons and goods**.
- (ii) All **commercial passenger transport vehicles** - bus, taxi, cab aggregators (OLA/Uber etc.) auto rickshaw, cycle rickshaw - are also permitted to ply subject ensuring **proper sanitization of the seats and touch points before and after each journey** and other safety precautions prescribed.
- (iii) Public (City) Transport as permitted vide Orders No.F.33(2)Home/Gr.9/2019 dated 22nd July, 2020 shall continue to remain effective.
- (iv) **The passengers** travelling in any vehicle (personal or commercial) **shall not exceed the permitted seating capacity** of the registered vehicle.
- (v) Movement by passengers trains and *shramik* special trains, domestic passengers air travel etc. will continue to be regulated by the SOPs issued by MHA, Government of India.

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F. IMPLEMENTATION MODALITIES

The implementation modalities shall be the same as per the Order of even number dated March 26th, 2020.
